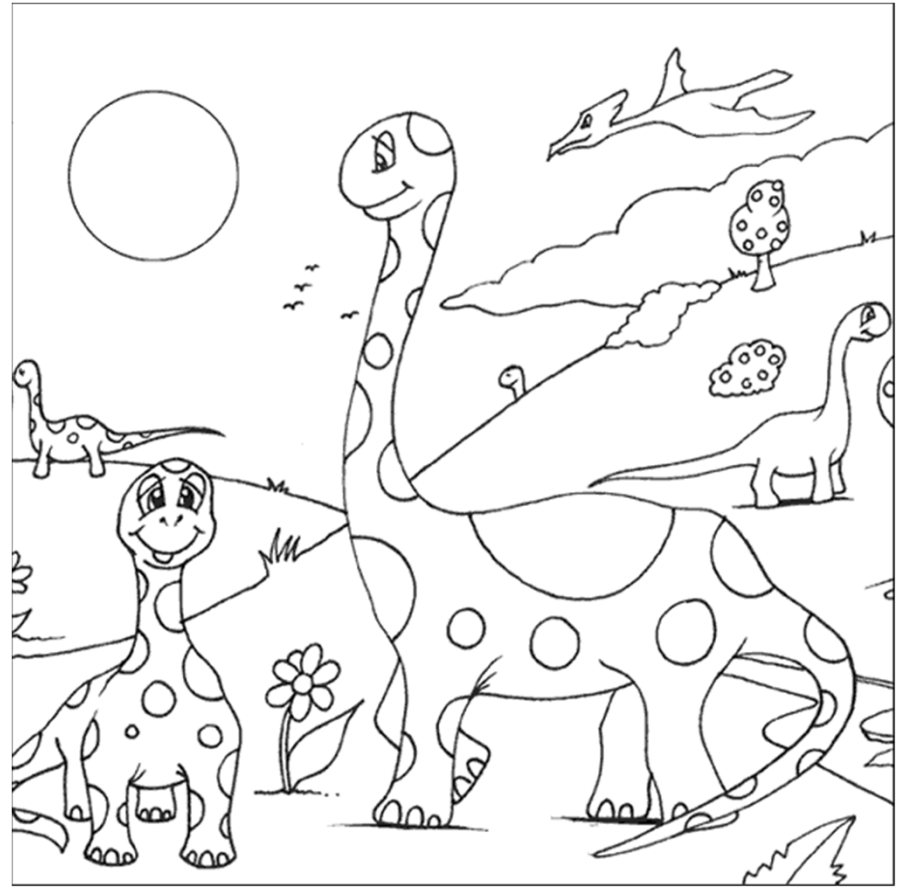
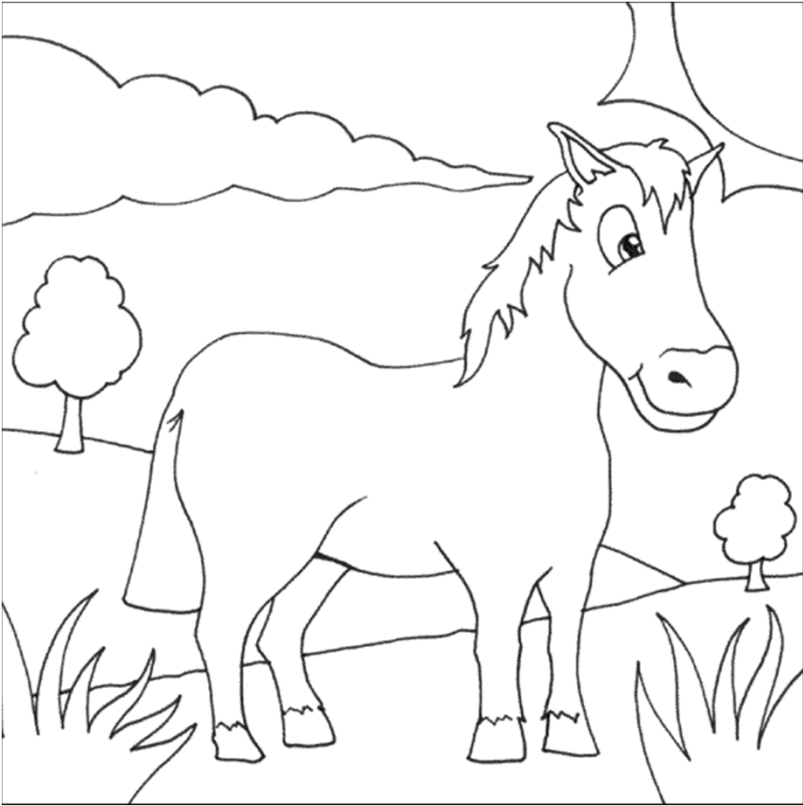
We want you to have food that you like and nice clean clothes and to be **HAPPY** and feel **SAFE** in your foster placement.



If you don't feel **HAPPY** and **SAFE** or you are **WORRIED** about anything at all, you can talk to:

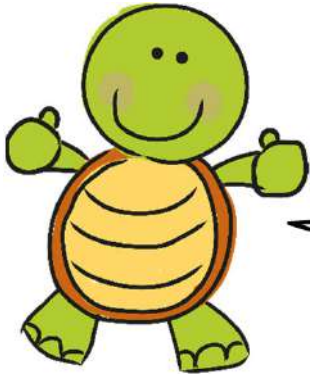

What to do if you need help...

If you have a problem that you don't feel like you can talk to your foster carer about you can talk to your Social Worker or The CFT Supervising Social Worker instead.



If you don't feel like you can talk to any of those people, you can contact us by using the postcard included in this pack.
